41	Hanson stated that the building is on the tax roll. The city will begin receiving tax increments for		
42	the building.		
43	Hanson read the requirements of the participation agreement, noting all benchmarks have been		
44	met. He stated that they have exceeded the occupancy requirement of the agreement.

46	Hanson stated that the terms of the participation agreement have been met.		

47	Board Member West stated that he likes having it on our tax rolls and broadening our tax base.			
48	Hanson stated that all the taxing entities were approving of the valuation that the building brings			
49	to the tax rolls. Hanson stated that the 1.2 million was designed so that the funds will eventually			
50	come back to the City.

53	RDA is a great way to incentivize growth that brings property taxes back into the city.
