**Temporary Disconnect Terms & Conditions**

- Application must be made by the legal property owner of this property.
- The stated utility account balance is current.
- Utility services must be disconnected for a minimum of three months. After one year on temporary disconnect, the Owner must reapply for temporary disconnect.
- The Owner is responsible to pay the established monthly solid waste collection and disposal fee and storm water fee.
- The Owner is responsible to pay for any usage, overage, leaks, water line breaks or additional fees that may occur.
- Water services will be turned off at the meter during the stated disconnect period.
- The Owner is responsible to notify the City to have services restored. The Owner shall notify the City within 2 business days prior to restoration date.
- A written temporary water connection request may be granted in order for the property to be privately inspected.

Washington Terrace City Municipal Code 13.04.022, Special Fees

It is unlawful for any person for any reason, other than authorized City personnel, to restore services after services have been disconnected. Failure to comply will be subject to the fines and penalties outlined in the Washington Terrace Municipal Code
